Greenwood-Itta Bena Alumnae Chapter History

The Chartering of Greenwood-Itta Bena Alumnae Chapter

The year was 1962, when sixteen concerned, devoted, and dedicated Deltas in the area of Greenwood, Itta Bena, and Indianola became interested in organizing a graduate chapter in this section of Mississippi. The sixteen Deltas met with Leola Williams, a member of Delta, an English teacher, and civic worker in Greenwood, Mississippi, to discuss the possibility of establishing an alumnae chapter in the Delta area of Mississippi, since there were no sororities or fraternities active in this immediate section of the state.

Most of the original sixteen women were employed at Mississippi Valley State College or in the public schools of Leflore and Sunflower counties. The group elected four officers: a president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer in order to make the necessary contacts to set up a chapter. Maggie McDowell of Memphis, Tennessee was the Regional Director at the time this chapter was established. Mrs. McDowell made many trips from Memphis to Itta Bena and gave great leadership and assistance in helping establish the chapter.

On December 14, 1963, the Greenwood-Itta Bena Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated received its charter; the following visionary, dynamic, and focused sorors are depicted as the sixteen charter members:

Ora Starks is an award-winning professor at her alma mater, Mississippi Valley State University (MVSU) in Itta Bena, Mississippi. Most recently, Dr. Starks received the Education Award where she was recognized by MVUS students on campus for her outstanding leadership.

Dr. Starks holds a bachelor of science and a master of science in Criminal Justice from Mississippi Valley State University, and received a doctoral degree in Human Services with a specialization in Criminal Justice at Walden University.

Professionally, Dr. Starks began her career in the criminal justice profession as a correctional officer with the Mississippi Department of Corrections (MDOC) in 1995. During her 17 years of tenure with MDOC, she worked tirelessly and was granted several opportunities to move up the ranks within the Department of Corrections. She has served as a Correctional Officer, Sergeant, Case Manager, Alcohol and Drug Coordinator, and Operations Management Analyst Principal (Compliance Officer/Auditor).

Advancements in her career afforded opportunities to serve as the Warden of Bolivar County Regional Correctional Facility in Cleveland, Mississippi. This appointment led to two major milestones in Bolivar County's history. Dr. Starks is the first female warden and the first African-American female to hold this position.

During Dr. Starks 26 years of tenure of corrections, she has received numerous awards and accolades. To add to her many recognitions, she co-authored a chapter for a book "Routledge Companion to Gender and Crime" for one of the top publishing companies Routledge Publishing.

Dr. Starks is a distinguish member of Greenwood-Itta Bena Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, where she serves as chair of the scholarship committee.

In her spare time, she enjoys various hobbies such as traveling, shopping, watching investigation shows, participating in public service, public speaking, and mentoring young ladies in the community.

Dr. Starks favorite scripture is Philippians 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ that strengthens me", and her quotes are "Excuses are for those who make them" and "Failure is not an option."




